In this course you will be introduced to an historical context. You will study this in depth then create your own drama in a group based on what you would like to show an invited audience. You will explore a range of scripts and understand how these need to be interpreted for performance. You will then learn at least one major performance style. You will also be expected to attend at least one live performance as a class during the year but will be offered more. There will be practical assessments of performances, in-class workshops, and expected involvement in lessons. You are expected to produce written assessments including research assignments, reviews, essays and journaling. There is one External Assessment at the end of the year based on what you have studied in class.*Individual programmes will be worked on to ensure that the standards meet the needs of the students.
