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### Paraparaumu College Code Statements

Paraparaumu College requires all international students to have both medical and travel insurance. Proof of insurance is required to be presented at the time of enrolment and insurance documents must be in English. We offer insurance that provides extensive travel and medical cover. Documentation is available from the International Department.

Paraparaumu College has agreed to observe and be bound by the Code of Practice for the Pastoral Care of International Students published by the Minister of Education. ### Immigration

### Eligibility for Health Services

International students are not entitled to publicly funded health services while in New Zealand. If you receive medical treatment during your visit, you may be liable for the full costs of that treatment. **Parental Agreement:  
INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TUITION CONTRACT  
(must be signed by Parent)**

I/We must:-

- 1) Give full accurate and honest information in all my application forms including medical and educational.
- 2) Will inform Paraparaumu College of any sickness, behavioural problems, disability or special education before enrolment is considered.
- 3) Follows all the rules and regulations of Paraparaumu College and to co-operate with staff at all times.
- 4) Accept the terms of Paraparaumu College refund policy.
- 5) Understand that my/our son/daughter must have satisfactory attendance at Paraparaumu College in order to keep their Student Visa. Paraparaumu College has the right to terminate this agreement and inform the NZ Immigration Service if our/my child fails to comply with the Ministry of Education attendance requirements.
- 6) Understand that my/our child must not take extra time away from school unless authorised by the Director of International Students, Paraparaumu College.
- 7) Understand that our/my child must not own or drive a motor vehicle while enrolled at Paraparaumu College.
- 8) Understand that the breaking of New Zealand law or continued misbehaviour at school or in the homestay may result in our son/daughter being sent home. This agreement being terminated
- 9) Understand and will provide documentation showing that our son/daughter has adequate travel, medical and personal loss insurance while in New Zealand.
- 10) Understand that my/our child will live in a homestay approved by Paraparaumu College for the length of the Visa/Permit and follow the rules applying within the homestay (see the homestay contract). No International Students enrolled at Paraparaumu College are permitted to live in flatting situation, regardless of age.
- 11) Understand that Paraparaumu College has the right to pass on relevant information about our child if necessary.
- 12) Agree to my/our child receiving any emergency, medical, dental or surgical treatments including anaesthetic or blood transfusions as considered necessary by the medical authorities at the time.
- 13) Agree to provide updated contact details at all times during the time of enrolment at Paraparaumu College.

I understand that failure to comply with any of the above requirements, undeclared health problem or breaking a New Zealand law could result in the contract being revoked and the normal school discipline procedures applied. If this occurs it is likely that the visa/permit would then be revoked by the New Zealand Immigration Service.

**SCHOOL'S OBLIGATION:**

1. Paraparaumu College shall provide tuition in accordance with that accorded to domestic students.
2. Paraparaumu College will assess the student's level in English and other subjects to determine course placement.
3. Paraparaumu College will not accept international students under 14 years of age.
4. Paraparaumu College will endeavour to ensure the safety, health and wellbeing of your son/daughter but shall not be liable for:-
  - a. Any damage or harm caused to the student or student's property while attending the school.
  - b. Any damage or harm caused to the students or the student's property arising out of the student's accommodation.

**REFUND POLICY FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

We will make every effort to ensure that the student's stay at Paraparaumu College is successful and rewarding. If a decision is made to withdraw from the school, it must be in full consultation with parents and agents.

To be eligible for a refund, an application must be made in writing to the Principal by the parents or legal guardian clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal of the student.

If the withdrawal is made before the student arrives in New Zealand, full tuition fees are refunded less the \$600 administration fee.

No refund will be made if the student is asked to leave school because of poor attendance, violation of the school rules or the rules of the New Zealand Government.

No refund will be made if the student transfers to another school.

No refund will be made if the student returns home for any reason other than serious illness or death or serious illness of a family member. (Medical evidence must be provided).

No refund will be made if they continually breach the Homestay Contract.

No refund will be made if the student leaves or gains permanent residency after the mid-point of his/her contract.
